



## **THANK YOU from the 16,131 people who received services from United Way agencies in 2007 . . .**

**American Red Cross: In 2007, 2,324 individuals were served because of your United Way investment.**

- \$56,500 to fund Disaster Services, Armed Forces Emergency Services, and Disaster Preparedness.

**Family Service Society: In 2007, 2,699 individuals received services from Family Service Society, 100% of these individuals were below poverty level.**

- \$25,000 to fund the dental program for low income families;
- \$7,000 to fund assistance for prescription medication for low income families;
- \$30,000 to fund utility assistance for low income families and individuals;
- \$13,000 to fund a food pantry for low income families and individuals;
- \$18,400 to fund a clothing closet for low income families and individuals.

**Four Rivers Behavioral Health: In 2007, 117 youth received mental health treatment and 38 men received drug treatment.**

- \$15,000 to fund the Children's Partial Hospitalization, ensuring that low income children receive professional mental health services;
- \$17,000 to fund drug treatment for those unable to afford treatment.

**Girl Scouts of Kentuckiana: In 2007, your United Way investment ensured that 203 low income girls could be involved in Girl Scouts.**

- \$8,260 to provide funds for low income girls to join Girl Scout program;
- \$8,890 to fund in-school Girl Scout program;
- \$2,500 to fund the Daisy Discovery program.

**Heartland CARES, Inc: In 2007, Your United Way investment assisted 189 children of HIV positive parents.**

- \$5,000 to fund support services and help meet the needs of children of HIV Positive parents;
- \$24,000 to fund a Volunteer Program.

**Oscar Cross Boys and Girls Club: In 2007, your United Way investment ensured that 985 youth in our community had a safe, structured, and positive place to go.**

- \$27,260 to fund the after school program for youth in our community;
- \$19,000 to fund a summer program for youth in our community;

**Paducah Day Nursery: In 2007, your United Way investment ensured that 119 children living at or below the poverty level received quality childcare.**

- \$120,000 to fund affordable quality childcare to children living at or below the poverty level.

**Purchase Area Sexual Assault and Child Abuse Center: In 2007, your United Way investment assisted 564 victims of sexual assault and/or child abuse.**

- \$5,000 to fund an educational program for school age children;
- \$16,000 to fund a clinical counseling program for victims;
- \$3,000 to fund a volunteer program;
- \$5,000 to fund a victim's advocacy program.

**Salvation Army: In 2007, your United Way investment helped support 6,754 individuals in need.**

- \$5,000 to fund a summer program for community youth;
