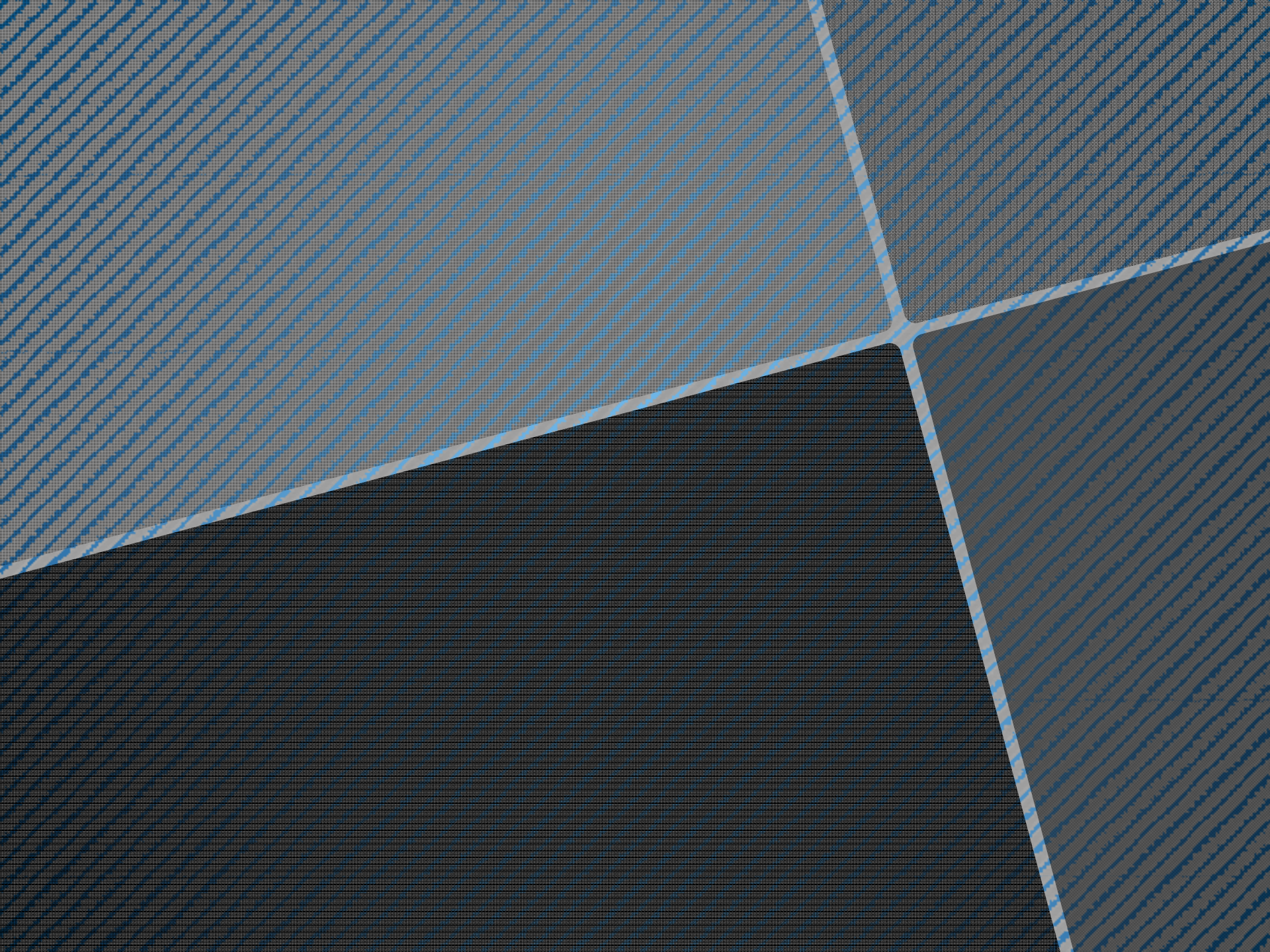

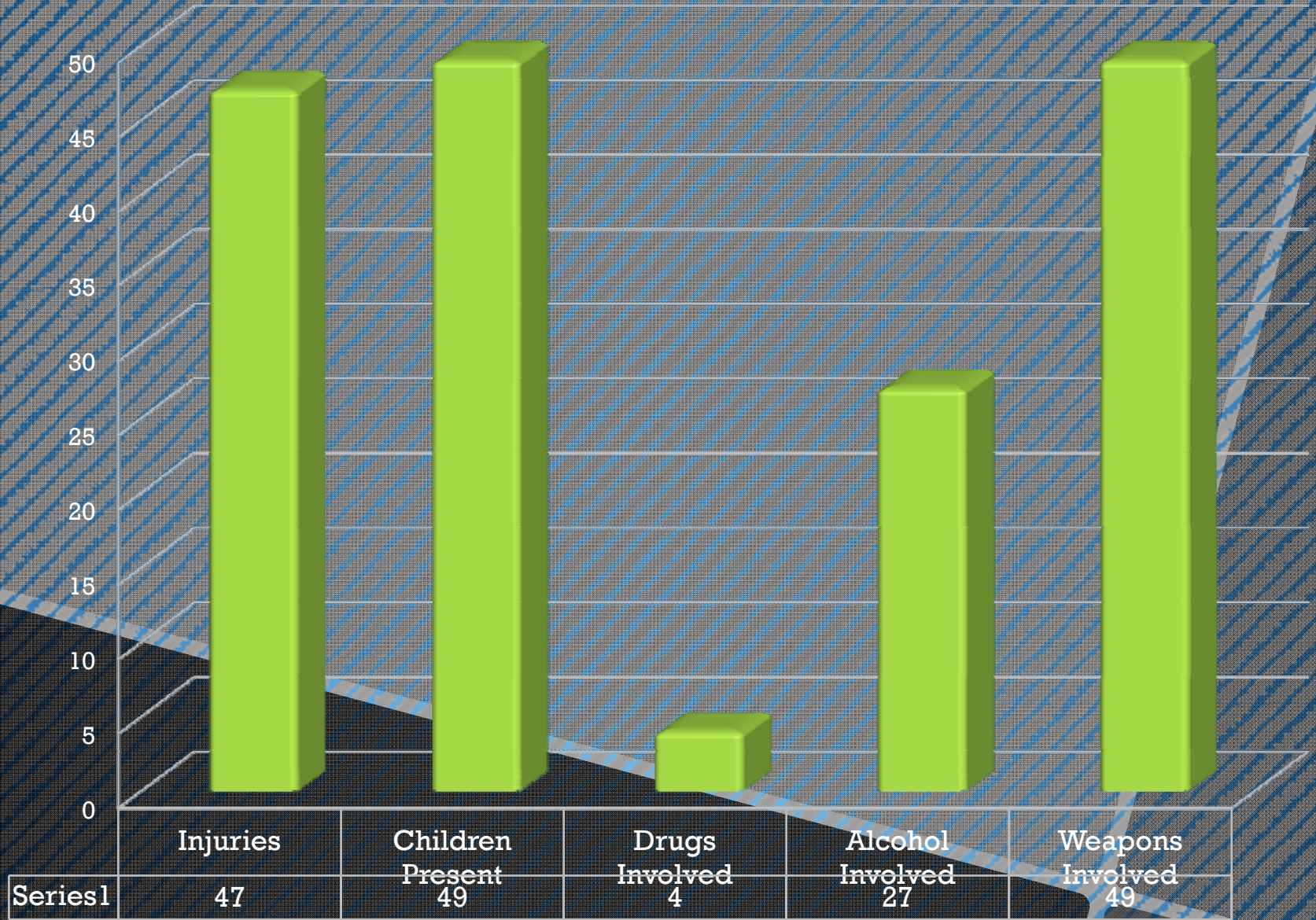

Impact of Domestic Violence on Communities

- In the US \$5.8B year spent due to domestic violence : \$4.1B on healthcare/medical cost and \$1.8B on productivity loss.
- Children in domestic violence situations are more likely to have behavioral, social and emotional problems, as well as cognitive problems in learning.
- A better way of battling domestic violence in communities is approaching it with a collaborative effort with law enforcement, schools, healthcare and state services. ***Educating the community is also vital.***
